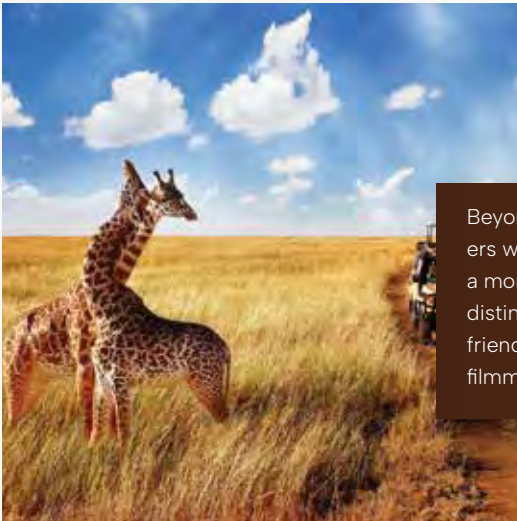

DAY 4

ABERDARE NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast this morning, we drive north through coffee and pineapple plantations to the Aberdares region to The Ark. Set in the heart of the Aberdare National Park, iconic and yes, quirky, The Ark overlooks a poodlit waterhole and salt lick, which attracts a host of awesome wildlife. Resembling and named after Noah's Ark, The Ark comprises of three decks from which numerous balconies and lounges provide a superb location for wildlife to be seen. So that you don't miss any animal sightings, the night guard will buzz your room when special animals come to the waterhole.

The Ark has four viewing areas for observing the ever-present animal activity. There is also a ground level bunker – the perfect hideout for the discerning photographer. This is a circular pillbox-like structure, and it is from this vantage point that pictures of animals on the salt lick only yards away may be taken through the view holes in complete safety.

LAKE NAKURU

Enjoy the entire day on game drives in Sweetwaters with morning and afternoon game drives through the Ol Pejeta Conservancy.

Boasting an incredible density of wildlife within its borders, the conservancy is also home to a host of endangered species. Ol Pejeta is especially known for its huge population of black rhinoceros. Return to camp for dinner and another pleasant evening. All meals are included with overnight at Sweetwaters Tented Camp. You may also partake in an optional game drive run by the camp that departs after dinner and explore the bush under cover of night when animals are grazing, sleeping, and hunting.

DAY 6

MASAI MARA

Setting out again after breakfast, we drive across the Great Rift Valley to the Maasai Mara, arriving in time for lunch at Mara Serena Safari Lodge. Set high on a hilltop above the Mara, the lodge is blessed with sweeping views of the savannah below. In the distance you can see the meandering coils of the hippo-filled Mara river.

The Maasai Mara Game Reserve is widely considered to be one of Africa's greatest reserves, where the Maasai community co-exists in harmony with the local fauna. The co-existence of man and wildlife makes this one of the world's most unique wilderness regions. The Mara is home to a breathtaking array of life. The vast grasslands are teeming with herds of zebra, giraffe, gazelle, and topi.

The acacia forests abound with monkeys and bird life. Elephants and buffalo wallow in the wide Musiara Swamp while the Mara and Talek rivers brim with hippos and crocodiles. From July through October, the Mara plays host to one of the greatest spectacles on the planet as millions of wildebeest, zebra, gazelle and topi head north from Tanzania into Kenya. Those fortunate enough to witness The Great Migration are treated to spectacular viewing and photographic opportunities.

BALLOON SAFARI ADD-ON

AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK

Optional but highly recommended, the Balloon Safari is a very popular excursion among visitors and can be added to a safari that includes a night at any of the camps/lodges in the Mara or Serengeti.

Meeting your pilot early in the morning, you will receive a briefing and watch as the balloon is inflated. You lift off at dawn, rising with the sun and gently float in whichever direction the winds of the morning take you. Below are the majestic plains of the African savannah, teeming with life. At times, your balloon will be piloted at treetop level, offering unique perspectives of the wildlife and many great photo opportunities.

Other times, the pilot will ascend to nearly 1,000 feet, offering a breathtaking perspective of the landscape below, allowing you to appreciate its profound size. On landing, enjoy a delicious champagne breakfast served in the bush.

DAY 8

SERENGETI

This morning, following an early meal, you'll head to Isebania, a frontier town, marking the start of your Tanzanian adventure into the Serengeti National Park. Your driver will guide you through the customs and immigration process.

After enjoying a picnic lunch, you'll resume your journey to the park, arriving at the Serengeti Serena Safari Lodge by dinner time. Along the way, you'll be treated to a wildlife spectacle. Later, relax on your private veranda overlooking the expansive plains of the renowned Serengeti.

Spanning 5,700 square miles, Serengeti National Park is vast, even exceeding the size of Connecticut. It has been under protection since the 1940s, attained

national park status in 1951, and is recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

The park is a marvel of nature and of immense scientific interest, hosting over four million animals across numerous species. You'll encounter diverse herds of antelope, including Patterson's eland, klipspringer, dikdik, impala, zebra, gazelle, waterbuck, topi, kongoni, Cotton's oribi, grey bush duiker, roan antelope, buffalo, and wildebeest.

It's also a bird watcher's haven, with nearly five hundred species like storks, flamingoes, vultures, fish eagles, and ostriches. Predators such as cheetahs, lions, leopards, as well as giraffes, hippos, and rhinos add to the park's grandeur, making it an almost complete directory of African wildlife.

DAY 8

SERENGETI

The varied landscape of the Serengeti—from the southern grass plains to central savannahs, northern hilly woodlands, and western black clay plains—supports this rich diversity of life.

With low-lying vegetation, the park offers excellent game viewing opportunities. The landscape is punctuated with rivers, lakes, and swamps and is a haven where animals wander freely. The Great Migration sees vast herds migrating from the Maasai Mara to the Serengeti, with the dramatic scene of half a million wildebeest giving birth in February. This spectacle in the southern Serengeti unfolds from December to May, before the herds move to the Mara again.

DAY 9

SERENGETI

Departing with the break of dawn, you immerse yourself in the African sunrise for a day dedicated to game viewing. Leaving the lodge behind, you enter a realm of natural splendor, an unchanged and ancient landscape where life's drama unfolds as it has for millennia.

Throughout the day, your driver's intimate understanding of the terrain is evident as he navigates to the most breathtaking vistas, providing ample opportunities to watch the wildlife at your pace. When the day reaches its zenith and the animals seek shade, you'll enjoy a secluded picnic lunch before continuing your adventure. Returning to the lodge at twilight, you'll reflect on the day's thrill, ready to relax.

Post a rejuvenating shower, dinner awaits at the main lodge. Later, you can sip a nightcap on your verandah, observing the nearby nocturnal activities of the Serengeti's inhabitants. The tranquility of the evening promises restful slumber, filled with dreams of this vast and vibrant land.

DAY 10

OLDUVAI GORGE & NGORONGORO

After breakfast at Serengeti Serena Safari Lodge, we drive to Olduvai Gorge, the “cradle of mankind” where the Leakey family uncovered fossils of Homo Habilis that have been dated to over 1.75 million years old. After a picnic lunch, we continue on to Ngorongoro Conservation Area and its famous wildlife-filled crater.

We arrive at the Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge in time for a dinner with a panoramic view of the crater. Perched on the rim of the crater, this luxurious lodge is constructed in the rustic style and offers sweeping views from each of its rooms – each with its own private balcony.

DAY 11

NGORONGORO CRATER

After breakfast, the driver guides your vehicle nearly 2,000 feet down into Ngorongoro Crater for a full day of exploration. In addition to viewing larger game, we will drive across the dense forest on the rim to the soda lake to view the outstanding bird life.

Today, we enjoy a picnic lunch in the crater itself and ascend back to the lodge for dinner and relaxation. Ngorongoro Crater was an active volcano some eight million years ago whose cone collapsed, leaving a deep crater. It is the largest unbroken caldera in the world, the second largest extinct crater, and today shelters arguably the most beautiful wildlife haven left on earth with a spectacular concentration of animals and stunning views.

This is undoubtedly the best place in Tanzania to see black rhinos as well as prides of lions with magnificent black-maned males. Elephant, leopard, buffalo, cheetah, zebra, warthog, a dozen antelope species, and nearly one hundred species of birds not found even in the Serengeti also live within its walls. The crater rim is wooded with mountain forest vegetation and is abloom in acres of pink, blue, and white lupines, candle white lilies, and blue hyacinth. The short grasses on the crater's floor make game easy to spot and photograph.

DAY 12

LAKE MANYARA

This morning, you wake one last time to the expansive view of Ngorongoro Crater from your room. After breakfast, we drive to Lake Manyara National Park, viewing game en-route to our lodge and arriving in time for lunch. After getting settled in, set out for an afternoon game drive and hope to see the park's famous tree-climbing lions. A wealth of bird life and large game roam the park and its lake, with the cliffs of the Great Rift Valley forming a stunning backdrop to it all.

The lodge is perched high above the lake with magnificent views from your room and the grounds. Dinner and overnight at Lake Manyara Serena Safari Lodge. The beautiful Lake Manyara covers two thirds of this national park; the rest consists of steep mountainside, swamps, dense woodlands, open grassy areas and hot springs.

One of the many alkaline lakes of the Great Rift Valley, it was formed three million years ago and is quite shallow – perfect for the 350 species of birds including pelicans, ibises, storks, Egyptian geese, and flamingoes. Baboons and black monkeys can be heard chattering in the woodlands near the park's entrance and a multitude of large game can be found traversing the low, grassy areas near the lake's shore.



After settling into your accommodations, set out into the bush for your first game-viewing drive. Later this afternoon, you will tour Sweetwater's Chimpanzee Sanctuary –the only facility of its kind in Kenya. The sanctuary provides an authentic habitat for rescued chimpanzees who cannot otherwise be re-introduced into the wild. It's a powerful and memorable experience that highlights the challenges and responsibilities of wildlife protection and conservation.

Upon your return to camp, you can relax on your private verandah overlooking the camp's extensive and lighted water hole, take a dip in the pool, or catalog the day's haul of wildlife photographs. After dinner, relax by the fire or retire to the wonderful ambiance of your tent. The camp's luxurious tents all feature comfortable beds, electricity, hot/cold running water, and full in-suite bathroom with shower.

After another lovely breakfast this morning, we head north to Samburu, arriving in time for lunch at Elephant Bedroom Camp. Enjoy an afternoon game drive through Samburu followed by dinner at the camp. Don't be surprised to find an elephant wandering down the path in this aptly-named camp.

Samburu National Reserve lies within the lands of the Samburu, cousins of the Maasai. The reserve is one of the best places to find several endemic northern species including gerenuk, reticulated giraffe, and Grevy's zebra. The area is quite arid, causing the game to congregate near the Ewaso Nyiro river which runs through the reserve. This concentration of wildlife makes game viewing particularly good




